Supplies Needed:

- **Cardstock/DSP:** Thick Basic White, Basic White, Floral Impressions DSP, Early Espresso, Pool Party, Pool Party and Pecan Pie Two-Tone, Woven Textures DSP, Brushed Gold Specialty DSP, Basic Black,
- **Stamp Sets and Die:** *Notes & Totes stamp set, Notes & Totes and Extraordinary Flora Die Cuts*
- **Ephemera:** Extraordinary Flora
- **Ink and Blends:** Early Espresso Classic Stampin' Pad
- **Tools & Adhesives:** Stampin' Seal Adhesive, Bone Folder, Cut & Emboss Machine, Sanding Block, Paper Trimmer, Liquid Glue, Stampin' Dimensionals, Acrylic Blocks





Cutting Measurements:

- **Card Base (Thick Basic White):** 4-1/4" x 11", scored at 5-1/2"
- **Pool Party and Pecan Pie Two-Tone** cardstocks cut to 4-1/4" wide and then torn
- **Fresh Freesia Two-Tone (die cut, crumpled, and sanded):** 4-1/2" x 4-1/2"
- **Scraps of Early Espresso** (tote), **Gold DSP and Basic Black** (sunglasses)
- **Inside Card Layer (Basic White):** 3-3/4" x 5", coordinating cardstock to mat (Pool Party): 3-7/8" x 5-1/8"

Instructions:

1. Fold the Thick Basic White cardstock on the score line to form card base.
2. Tear, stamp as desired on Pecan Pie and Pool Party Two-Tone cardstocks and layer on card base until satisfied with the look.
3. Die cut tote bag from DSP and pieces from Early Espresso scraps. Die cut glasses from Basic Black and Gold DSP scraps. Die cut scarf and bottles from DSP. Adhere together and place on card front until satisfied with the look.
4. I used scraps of the Ephemera I had already cut out. However, if you do not have scraps, adhere the Ephemera to a Basic White scrap and die cut. Then adhere to the card front until satisfied with the look.
5. Stamp sentiment on card front with Early Espresso, only inking up the "relax" word on the stamp.
6. For the inside, adhere the Basic White panel onto the Pool Party mat and then adhere to inside of card.
7. Embellish the card front as desired. I only added one glimmer gem on the tote as "button" to close the front pocket.

Tips for Success:

- ✓ **Take your time and have fun** This card is a true original – no two are going to look alike – and that's okay!
