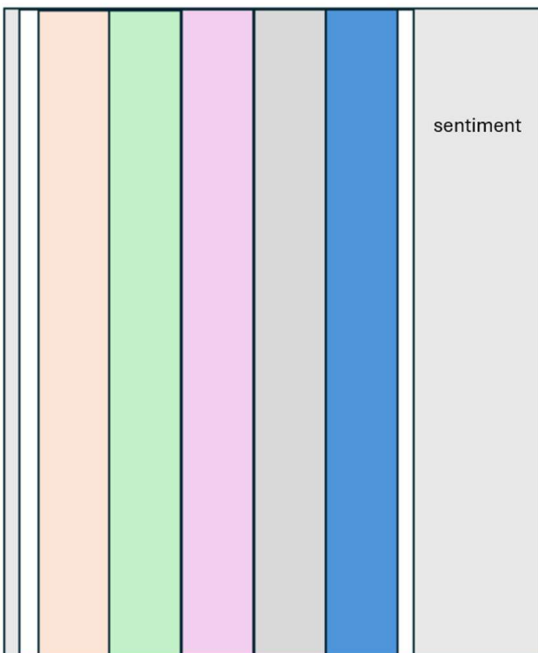


This is your “pattern” for creating this project. It’s designed to work with any stamps, ink, and paper you may have on hand and is intended to be your starting point for some fun.

This project sheet gives you the measurements for all the layers and general placement - but remember, it’s only a guide. Go ahead and vary your sizes and shapes and add additional layers (or take some away).

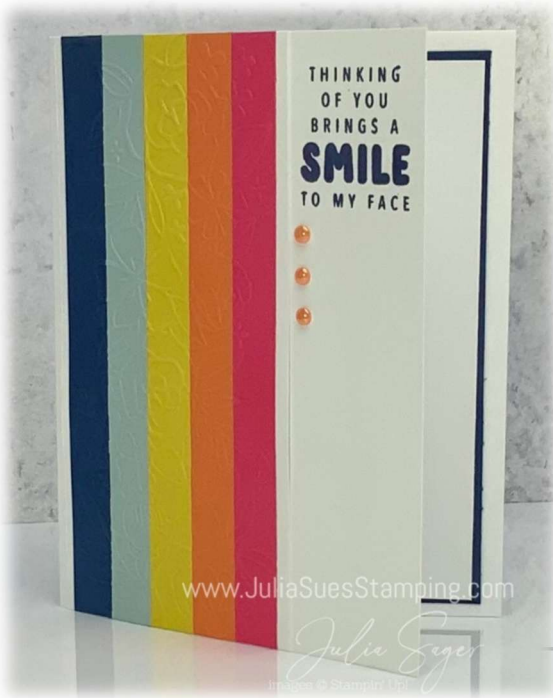
TIPS:

- For a quick and easy project - follow exactly
- Layers can be embossed or stamped - be creative and remember the template is only a guide
- Make it Your Own - add embellishments, additional layers or take some away
- Relax and enjoy the process. Crafting is meant to be fun!

Supplies Needed:

- **Cardstock:** Basic White, Night of Navy, Cloud Cover, Darling Duckling, Timid Tiger, Strawberry Slush
- **Ink:** Night of Navy Classic Stampin' Pad
- **Tools & Adhesives:** *Glass & Gardens* Embossing Folders (used: *Gardens*), Mini Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, Stampin' Seal Adhesive, Paper Trimmer, Take Your Pick Tool
- **Embellishments:** 2025-2027 In Color Flat Pearls
- **Stamp Set:** *Pattern of Friendship* stamp set

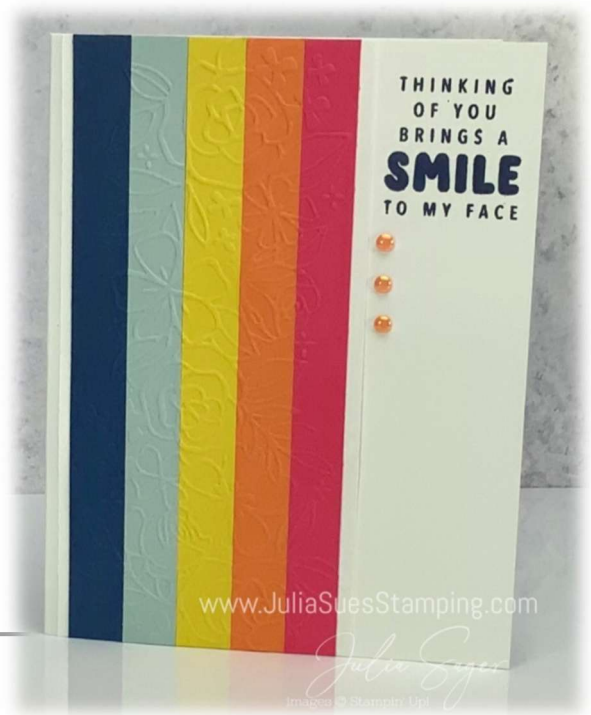
Cutting Measurements:

- **Card Base (Basic White):** 5-½" x 8-½", scored at 4-¼"
- **Striped Art Panel Base (Basic White):** 2-¾" x 5-½"
- **Color Strips (Night of Navy, Cloud Cover, Darling Duckling, Timid Tiger, Strawberry Slush):** Each ½" x 5-½"
- **Inside Card Layer (Basic White):** 3-¾" x 5"
- **Inside Card Coordinating Cardstock Mat (Night of Navy):** 3-7/8" x 5-1/8"

Instructions:

1. **Assemble the Striped Art Panel:** Adhere the five colored cardstock strips to the Basic White panel base, aligning them evenly across the width, leaving some white on each side – you can always trim this if needed.
2. **Emboss the Panel:** Place the completed striped panel inside the *Gardens* embossing folder and run it through the Mini Cut & Emboss Machine for beautiful floral texture.
3. **Create the Card Base:** Fold the scored Basic White cardstock in half to form your card base.
4. **Stamp the Sentiment:** Using Night of Navy ink, stamp the sentiment "Thinking of You Brings a Smile to My Face" from the *Pattern of Friendship* set on the upper right portion of the card front.

5. **Adhere the Art Panel:** Position the embossed striped panel on the left side of the card front and adhere it using Stampin' Seal.
6. **Add Embellishments:** Place three Timid Tiger Flat Pearls vertically beneath the sentiment using your Take Your Pick Tool for a bit of playful shine.
7. **Complete the Inside:** Adhere the Basic White inside panel to the Night of Navy mat. Then adhere to the layered piece to the inside of your card.



Additional Tips for Success:

- **Strong Adhesive Matters:** Since the stripes will be embossed afterward, use a strong adhesive like **Stampin' Seal** to ensure they stay firmly in place through the pressure of the embossing process.
- **Let the Embossing Do the Work:** The *Gardens* embossing folder adds so much detail! For best results, be sure your stripes are fully adhered before embossing so the folder can press evenly across the panel.
- **Adjust Your Strip Order:** Feel free to play with the color order to suit your mood or occasion! The layout is flexible and works beautifully with many color palettes—not just the 2025–2027 In Colors.
- **Stamp Before You Assemble:** Stamp your sentiment **before** adhering the art panel to the card front. That way, if something goes awry, you can flip the card base or swap it out without redoing the stripes.
